Further Records of Two Adventive Beetle Species (Insecta, Coleoptera) from Ukraine [Дальнейшие находки двух адвентивных видов жуков (Insecta, Coleoptera) в Украине]. — *Harmonia axyridis* (Pallas, 1773) (Coccinellidae) (Asian lady beetle, Japanese ladybug, Harlequin ladybird, Multicolored Asian lady beetle, Halloween lady beetle) originally native to eastern Asia, but has been introduced to North America and Europe to control aphids and scale insects. This species was recently recorded from Poland (Przewoźny, Barłożek, Bunalski, 2007), Slovakia (Marky, Pozsgai, 2009), Romania (Marky, Pozsgai, 2009), Hungary (Merkl, 2008; Marky, Pozsgai, 2009) and Ukraine (Marky, Pozsgai, 2009; Некрасова, Титар, 2009). New records: Odessa Region: 2 exs., Berezivka distr., Raukhivka, 12.06.2010, 8.08.2010, mercury vapor lamp 250 W; 1 ex., 18 km NO Odessa, Yuzhniy, 7.11.2010, on the wall (G. Demidov leg.). Transcarpathian Region: 1 ex., Rakhiv distr., Keveliv, 5.07.2010, on the wing; 2 exs., Rakhiv distr., Dilove env., 19.07.2010, on shrubs; 1 ex., Tyachiv distr., Mala Ugolyka, 9.07.2010, on the wing; 1 ex., Tyachiv distr., Shirokiy Lug, 12.07.2010, on the road; 1 ex., same data, 13.07.2010, on the wing. *Diabrotica virgifera virgifera* LeConte, 1868 (Chrysomelidae) (Western corn rootworm), originally native in Central and South America, a quarantine pest recently introduced to North America and Europe was reported from Ukraine for the first time in 2001. New records: 3 exs., Transcarpathian Region, Rakhiv distr., Lug env., Kuziy, 18.07.2007, h~1100 m., meadow, sweep-netting; 2 exs., same data but 19.07.2007; 1 ex., Odessa Region, Sawrany env., near Polyantetzke, 23.06.2008, sweep-netting. — The material was collected by the autor and is deposited in the autor's collection if not otherwise stated — **A.
